On Friday, 28 September, the San Diego County Public Health Officer issued a health alert for Undergraduates of San Diego State University related to recent cases of serogroup B invasive meningococcal disease.

Meningococcal serogroup B vaccination (MenB) is recommend for undergraduate students <24 years old who have not previously been immunized with one of the available MenB vaccines
