

## Nominating Petition

### COLLEGE OF ARTS & LETTERS SENATOR

The College of Arts and Letters must elect six additional representatives to the SDSU Senate.

The term of office for five of the open seats will begin in May 2012 and end in May 2015.

The term of office for the last open seat will begin in May 2012 and end in May 2013.

According to 4.254 of Bylaws in the Policy File,

4.254 When the election involves terms of different lengths, the candidates who receive the greatest number of votes on the ballot resulting in their being elected shall receive the longest term available. Ties shall be broken by lot. Service for a short term shall be considered a partial term; therefore, the person elected remains eligible to serve two additional consecutive full terms.

Elections are conducted according to the SDSU Policy File, which is located on the Senate website. Questions, please contact the Senate office at 594-5320.

NOTE: Lecturers and those without faculty, librarian, or counselor rank are ineligible for this election. For purposes of Senate elections, a member of the faculty refers to tenured or tenure-track faculty and shall be defined as one who has a full-time academic year appointment to the university, whether or not full time is devoted to teaching.
