<i>Rel</i>	<i>Relevance:</i> relevance of chosen study abroad program to applicant's academic program, career goals, and/or community service activities; evidence of a well-planned program and outcomes	0-5	5 if very relevant; clear outcomes 0 if not relevant; unclear outcomes
<i>Int</i>	<i>Integration:</i> overall impression of student's ability and commitment to become immersed in the host community (consider things like language learning/ability, points of contact, etc).	0-5	5 if high ability/commitment 0 if low ability/commitment
<i>Qual</i>	<i>Essay Quality:</i> overall quality of content and grammar in the three essays	0-5	5 if very well written 0 if poorly written
<i>Imp</i>	<i>Impact on Campus:</i> overall impression of the student's ability to impact the SDSU campus, the academic field of study, or the global community (both short- and long-term) as a result of the study abroad experience	0-3	3 if potential impact is great 0-1 if potential impact is limited
