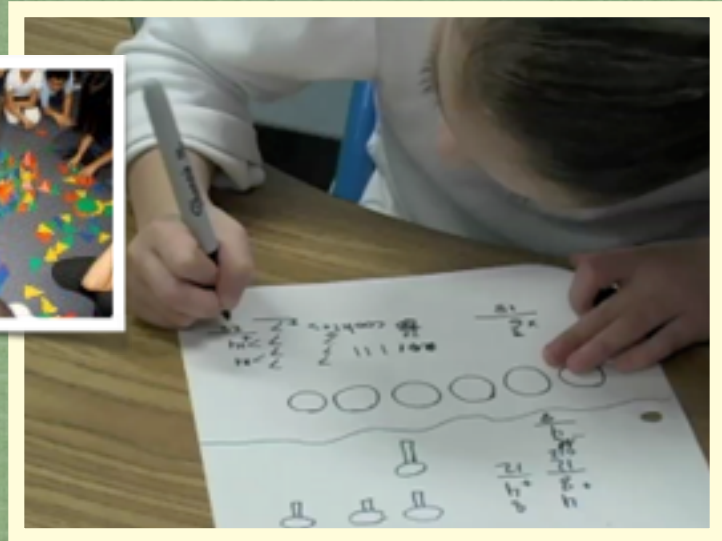


Learn about how students' math ideas can guide your instruction and earn a \$250 stipend.

Cognitively Guided Instruction (CGI) math professional development provides teachers the opportunity to learn more about children's mathematical thinking and how to use this information to guide their instruction. By collaborating with other teachers and San Diego State University faculty members, teachers can gain new insights into children's solution strategies, instructional techniques, and ways to implement Common Core.

PD Activities. We will meet July 26, 27, and 28, 2016 from 8:30-3:30 and then the second Wednesday of the month from 4:30-6:30pm, Sept. to May, where we watch students solve problems, listen to and analyze students' explanations and work, and discuss Common Core Standards. Teachers will also participate by bringing in students' work samples.

Responsibilities. Teachers are asked to attend all summer and after school meetings, pose problems of the month in your classroom, collect student work to be analyzed during the sessions, and possibly record student explanations with voice recorders.
