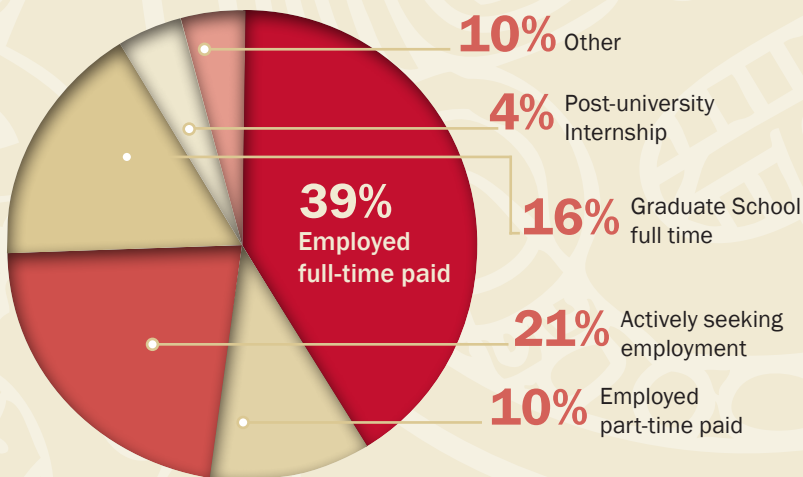

**NO DEBT: 40%**

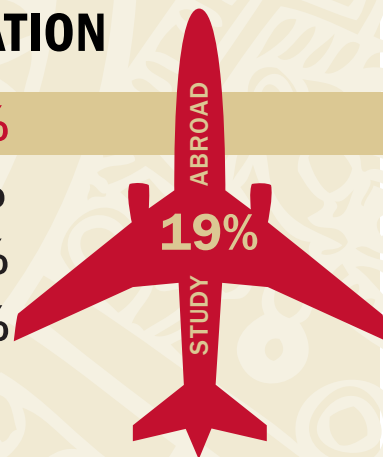
UP TO \$10K: 21%
